**TAKE NOTICE THAT** an appeal has been lodged in the Tribunal against the whole decision of the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) the Respondent herein in Compliance Order 01-07-2016, dated 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2016 in respect of creating artificial shortage of petroleum products and for contravening the law.

The Appellant contends, among other things, that the Respondent's conclusion that the Appellant's failure to adhere to Regulation 6 of the Petroleum (General) Regulations, GN No. 163 of 2011 created an artificial shortage of petroleum products, is unreasonable as it is neither supported by law nor fact and therefore the whole decision of the Respondent be quashed.
