TAKE NOTICE THAT an appeal has been lodged in the Tribunal against the whole decision of the Fair Competition Commission (FCC) dated 17th November, 2020 in respect of merger application No. FCC/M&A/19/2020 by the 1st appellant to acquire entire shares of the 2nd appellant in which FCC decided not to entertain the merger application for being in bad standing of the law.

The Appellants contend, among other grounds, that the FCC erred in law and fact in deciding as it did without basis and in breach of rules of natural justice. Thus, the Appellants pray for orders to quash and set aside the whole decision with costs; directing the FCC to re-determine and/or allow the merger and any other relief which the Tribunal deems fit.

BY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE any person who considers that he has sufficient interest may apply to intervene in the proceedings within seven days of the first publication of this notice to the Fair Competition Tribunal, 2nd Floor, Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology Building, Jamhuri Street, Dar Es Salaam.
