TAKE NOTICE THAT an appeal has been lodged in the Tribunal against the whole decision of the Fair Competition Commission (FCC) dated 17th February, 2021 in respect of FCC Complaint Docket No. FCC/Comp. 4 of 2021.

The Appellants contend, among other grounds, that issuance of the Compliance Order before issuance of Provisional Findings is *ultra vires* and that FCC erred in law and fact in concluding that the Appellants have infringed the Fair Competition Act No. 3 of 2003 basing on the Statement of the Case issued by the FCC. Thus, the Appellants pray for orders to quash and set aside the whole Compliance Order with costs and any other relief which the Tribunal deems fit.

BY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE any person who considers that he has sufficient interest may apply to intervene in the proceedings within seven days of the first publication of this notice to the Fair Competition Tribunal, 2nd Floor, Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology Building, Jamhuri Street, Dar Es Salaam.
